

ANNUAL VISIT CONSENT FORM

PART A To be retained by the parent or carer

Throughout the year the school organises a number of routine visits and journeys away from the school site as part of the children's learning experiences. Such visits take place during the school session times and tend to be local within the Sutton area.

Visits and journeys during the school day are an extension to their classroom activities and present no significant risk to the health and safety of the pupils.

All visits and journeys away from the school site must be approved by the Headteacher.

The purpose of this consent form is to enable parents/carers of children at the school to give their permission for their child to participate in visits and journeys away from the school during the school day.

This consent will allow your child to leave the school site for a local visit on several occasions without having to sign a separate consent form for each visit.

- Examples of such visits are:
- Visits to the Local Park
 - Visits to local shops
 - Visits to the church
