The average 'scaled score' in reading is 97.6 (National 102.6) and maths is 98.7 (National 103)

Table showing the average progress scores.

Progress scores are calculated in the following way:

Key stage one results are used to calculate an average point score for each child. This is then compared with the scaled score a child achieved at the end of year 6 and the difference between these two scores is calculated. These individual differences are averaged for the whole cohort in each subject.

- A score of 0 means pupils, on average, do about as well at key stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive score means pupils on average do better at key stage 2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A negative score means pupils on average do worse at key stage 2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.
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Hillocks progress scores are very similar to national expectations.
