Our School Aims

- That we create a suitable environment in which learning can take place that is also safe and secure.
- That the children want to come to school, feel at ease and emotionally secure and are happy to learn.
- To work in partnership with parents to ensure they understand the link between attendance, punctuality and learning.
- That we ensure children are achieving good standards in all areas of the curriculum.
- That we provide a broad base of knowledge, skills and understanding which includes the national curriculum.
- That appropriate challenge in learning is made to ensure children achieve their full potential.
- That we listen to children, are respectful of their needs and they, in turn, are respectful of others' to promote an atmosphere of mutual respect.
- That the adults in school present positive role models in order to promote acceptable conduct by pupils.
- That excellent teacher/parent-carer relationships are maintained and further developed.
- To work in partnership with parents to provide clear boundaries for behaviour in which all children can operate.
- That the children develop a sense of community and an awareness of the wider society and their role within it.
- To liaise with other agencies to ensure the well-being of our children. (N.B. We have a duty to inform social services if we have a concern regarding a child.)
