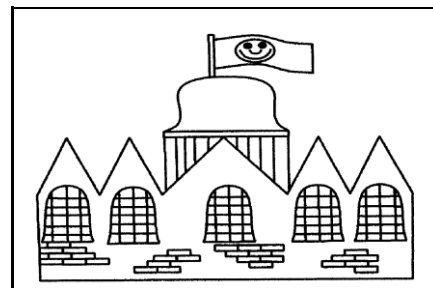

Hillocks Primary School and Nursery Unit is situated just off the A38 on the outskirts of Sutton in Ashfield.

The main school building was built in the early 1900's and was completely refurbished about 20 years ago. The main building has 5 classrooms, a Nursery Unit, 2 offices, a central hall where children eat school lunches, a resource/support room a staff room.

The school was inspected earlier this year and many strengths were identified.

There are 3 new classrooms separate to the main building. There is a refurbished large sports hall with changing and shower facilities, a P.E. Store and a large range of P.E. equipment. We also have 2 new mobile classrooms at the bottom of the play area and a new permanent classroom

The school has a nursery unit with its own fenced off playing area.

We have a large playing field and a netball/basketball court and a newly developed outside play area.

The school has a small garden area which is currently being developed by our children in the Gardening Club and we are also developing our Forest Schools on the playing field.

Currently there are 337 pupils.

Class structure:

Nursery Unit,

2 X F2 classes

K.S.1 3 classes: Y1/Y2

K.S.2 6 classes: Y3, Y4, Y5, Y6

The foundation stage unit offers 50 full time places and 60 part-time places. There are currently 11 classes in the primary department, 6 of which are taught in the main building, 3 in the new classrooms, 3 in the mobile classrooms.

The Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher, literacy, numeracy and ICT coordinators and a senior TA make up the Senior Management Team. Additionally there is an office manager, and a site manager and three cleaners. School meals are cooked by our kitchen team on the premises. There are twelve mid-day supervisors including one senior.

The successful candidate will be a flexible and dedicated team member with the initiative to be pro-active and to work cooperatively and supportively with the staff to enhance and improve the premises and the well-being of all who work in the school.

All staff working in a school have some degree of responsibility for safeguarding children depending on the nature of the post. The school is committed to safeguarding children. All staff are expected to follow procedures for safeguarding children at our school
