



Key Stage 1 Autumn Curriculum Overview



Welcome back to you all after the summer break. Our topic this half term is called Memory Box. We are very excited about this and look forward to learning more about each other

In Geography we will be looking at the local area and geographic features. This will include have a walk around and identifying these before creating our own maps with a key.

Our Art and DT this half term will see the children designing their own memory box whilst developing their observational drawing.

In Maths the children will be learning about number and place value. We will be beginning to understand the value of numbers up to 100 and begin learning our 2's, 5's and 10 times tables.

In English the children will be beginning our new Read, Write Inc programme. More news on this to come! We will be sharing a story together every day encouraging reading for pleasure.

In Science the children will be learning about the human body and how to stay fit and healthy. We will even be designing our own menu for a picnic based on a balanced diet.

On Friday 14th September, the children will take part in our launch day. We will be taking part in a Memory Munch picnic where we will all eat together and talk about our childhood experiences together and see how they have changed over generations.

For homework this half term, the children will be continuing to access Mathematics. They will receive weekly spellings and be expected to read at least 5 times a week.
