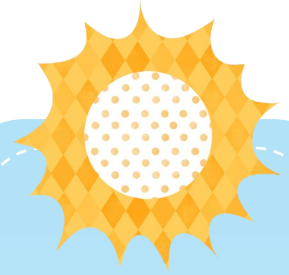


Weekly Newsletter 9th November 2018
